The purpose of the present Colloquium is to briefly re-view the main ideas and motivation behind the criticality hypothesis as a possible guiding principle in the collective organization of living systems and to scrutinize and discuss in a critical way the existing empirical evidence and prospects. It also aims at providing the reader with a self-consistent view of what is criticality and what it is not, as well as an overview of the literature on this active and fascinating research field with countless ramifications. A similar argument holds in the active phase. The large variability of possible patterns is a generic key feature of criticality. To better quantify this, a related quantity, dubbed dynamic range, was introduced in Kinouchi and Copelli (2006). outflows of funds related to changes in the holdings of assets and liabilities, subject to the adjustment that when changes in assets or liabilities give rise to an inflow, the respective flow is set to zero (formally: gross outflows = $\max(-\text{net assets flows}, 0) + \max(-\text{net liabilities flows}, 0)$). We analyze the impact of an outflow control tightening on net capital inflows as well as net flows of assets and liabilities and the gross inflow and outflow concepts defined as discussed above.
