

# Teaching and Learning Multiliteracies (ebook): Changing times, changing literacies

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Whilst change is often viewed as a positive occurrence, recently teachers of literacy have experienced a rapid period of change in both their practice and the theoretical and research based beliefs that underpin it. This chapter will provide a brief overview of some of the ways in which literacy pedagogy has encompassed a diverse range of forms of communication and meaning making commonly referred to as multiliteracies. Teachers of literacy were therefore seen as teachers of reading and writing who used predominately written texts to deliver their teaching. These aspects are important considerations in teaching multiliteracies in a relevant and meaningful way. However, participating in a range of literacies still requires the ability to read and write. Following a preface, this book introduces these six chapters: (1) Changing Times, Changing Literacies; (2) Defining Multiliteracies; (3) Developing Pedagogies for Multiliteracies; (4) The New Literacies and Children's Literature; (5) The Consumption and Production of Text; and (6) Planning for Multiliteracies.
