The toothed whales travel in large, sometimes stable pods; they frequently hunt their prey in groups, migrate together, and share care of their young. Baleen whales usually travel alone or in small pods. TOOTHED WHALES. Gray whales are often found swimming in the eastern north pacific ocean, and near Korea in the western north pacific ocean; however recent spottings in areas such as the Mediterranean sea suggests that these marine mammals may begin repopulating areas that may have become abandoned due to previous whaling activities. Every October, small groups of gray whales make long migration trips from their feeding grounds in the Bering and Chukchi seas and migrate to the Baja peninsula of Mexico and the southern Gulf of California, where they mate and bear their offspring. 10. The only known natural predators to the gray whale is a pod of killer whales. In terms of other predators, gray whales may also face occasional attacks by whale poachers and hunters.
