Their affinities to other groups of odontocetes were unresolved, mainly because they have many plesiomorphic characters. There are four genera of living "river dolphins": Platanista, Lipotes, Inia, and Pontoporia. Diet: Chinese River Dolphins feed of fish found in the Yangtze River. They use their long beaks to probe muddy river bottoms for prey. Senses: Chinese River Dolphins are thought to have very poor eyesight, they use touch and echolocation to navigate. Description: Chinese River Dolphins are white, pink, yellow, brown, gray, or black. Chinese River Dolphins have a thick stocky build, they have a narrow, long beak with an upturned tip.
