At a December 6th House Transportation and Infrastructure, Subcommittee on Coast Guard and Navigation hearings, Members, the Secretary of Transportation, and the Commandant of the Coast Guard expressed concern over the Coast Guard's ability to balance all its responsibilities. Supplemental funding may address some of the immediate shortfalls, but long-term strategic planning and budgeting appears necessary in light of what the Commandant calls the "new normalcy."
